



We are happy to announce that from 21 October to 8 November a National Philatelic Exhibition will take place, in the House of Cyprus, located inside the Cyprus Embassy building in Greece, 2A Xenofontos str., Athens.

The exhibition "Hellas-Cyprus 2013" is expected to be held under the patronage of the Hellenic Philatelic Federation (EFO) and will include all competitive classes. Exhibitors from Greece and abroad, preferably with exhibits of Greek and Cypriot philatelic interest, are invited to participate. New exhibits and first-time exhibitors will get priority, in order to be given the opportunity to meet the qualification criteria for participation in future international exhibitions.

Following two consecutive visits by members of the Administrative Council of the Hellenic Philatelic Society on 26 February and 4 April and the respective talks with Ms. Maria Ragia, Educational Officer in the House of Cyprus, it was decided that exhibition requirements will be best met in the large hall of the visual arts of the second floor of the Cyprus Embassy building. In this exhibition hall, 125 exhibition frames will be properly arranged in order to host two groups of exhibits in two periods: Period A exhibits will be on display from 21 to 30 October, while period B exhibits will be on display from 31 October to 8 November 2013.
